The Literary & Debating Club organized an essay competition in English and Malayalam as part of "Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav" on 10 on 10 August 2022.





As part of celebrating Mahotsav" Botany Amrit Department organised a patriotic writing competition song Malayalam, English and Hindi.





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




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World Environmental Celebration


