Sl No	Programme	Name of the Course	Course Code	Description
1	MSc Zoology	Developmental Biology	ZL010202	Covers concepts like environmental estrogens and their impact on development.
2	MSc Zoology	Microbiology and Biotechnology	ZL010204	Explores gene therapy and biotechnological advancements which can include discussions on gender-specific treatments and health care solutions.
3	BSc Zoology	Environmental Biology and Human Rights	ZY5CRT05	This course includes a module on Human Rights covering main concepts associated with Human Rights, different types of human rights, role of agencies in promoting human rights, mechanisms for checking violations of human rights, and constitutional provisions related to human rights.
4	BSc Zoology	Cell Biology and Genetics	ZY5CRT14	This course involves topics related to cell structure and functions, genetics, and includes discussions on human health, reproductive health, and the importance of sex education.

Students critically respond to literature from a feminist perspective, realize how patriarchal notions pervade the social and cultural scenario, and identify how stereotypical representations of women were constructed and how these are subverted by feminist writing.
10	BA English Language and Literature Model 1	Literature and/as Identity	EN3CC05	The course explores the relationship between literature and identity, including how literature reflects and influences social identities such as gender.
11	BA English Language and Literature Model 1	Issues that Matter	EN2CC03	The course encourages students to critically engage with these topics, fostering a deeper awareness and promoting positive responses to gender issues in today's world.
12	MA English	Literature and Gender	EN010304	This course highlights the historic, thematic, and cultural concerns of literature against the backdrop of gender issues. It examines gender through political, religious, and social lenses, viewing gender as a fluid concept. Topics include masculinity, femininity, community identity, and patriarchal oppression portrayed in various Indian languages.
13	B.Com. Finance and Taxation Model I	Environment Management and Human Rights	CO5CRT15	This course covers various aspects of environment management and human rights, including gender equality and women's rights.
