INDUSTRIAL VISIT REPORT 2019-2020

Report on Industrial visit 2019 BBA In the view to fulfill the academic requirement and to bring the students to an exposure to the industrial functions, industrial visit is carried on as and how permissions from the industry is available. An industrial visit to Kerala Bamboo Corporation Ltd, Angamaly, Meriboy Ice Cream Factory and Tejus foods Perumbavoor was organized for BBA students on 28th November 2019. 90 students had registered their names for the same and 4 faculties had joined them. Betna Rodrigues, Jeffy Thomas, Febin George and Vijayakumar were the faculties in charge for the visit. The journey began from the college premises on 28th November 2019.

The first visit was made to Kerala Bamboo Corporation Ltd Angamaly. The students got an opportunity to understand the market scenarios, the importance of quality in manufacturing bamboo products etc. from the visit.

The second visit was made straight to the Meriboy Ice-cream Factory. The staff from the factory explain automation of dairy. The students can see machineries at work and how Ice creams are processed and packed.

The third visit was made to Tejus foods, Perumbavoor. The students were able to observe and learn the process of preparing variety food items, the working pattern at the factory, types of machinery used and its functioning. The students also observed the process of packing and sealing food items through an automated machine for a pre-fixed net weight and for a fixed number of packets. Students got a rare opportunity to see the variety of items which were in the process of preparation. The visit was a fruitful one with an interactive session.

INDUSTRIAL VISIT REPORT 2022-2023

The department of economics arranged an industrial visit to Munnar Tea factory for the Second Year BBA and Third year BBA on 01-12-2022. The students were accompanied by the three faculty members of the department-Betna Rodrigues (HOD), Jeffy Thomas, Febin George and Aswathy Regunath. The students visit tea factory and museum and got to know many interesting facts related to the process of manufacturing tea and all other related aspects of selling and distribution. The KDHP Tea Museum is an industry and history museum situated in Munnar, a town in the Idukki district of Kerala in South India. Tata Tea Museum is its official name, but it's also known as Nalluthanni Estate where it is located, or Kannan Devan Hills Plantation (KDHP) Tea Museum. It started in 1905 and is now a fully automotive factory. The tea museum preserves the aspects on the genesis and growth of tea plantations in Kerala. The museum houses curiosities, photographs and machineries, depicting a turning point that contributed to Idukki's flourishing tea industry. different process through which the tea is processed were witnessed by the students at various stages of the tea processing such as Crush, tear, curl - and learn about the production of Kerala black tea variants. A section of the museum also houses classic bungalow furniture and office equipment of the Colonial area in Kerala, model of rail engine operated in 1924. The. They also acknowledge the history of Munnar by going through the history of tea gardens in Munnar. The students were provided facility for purchasing different varieties of tea and enjoyed a cup of delicious freshly prepared tea.



Students were trained to identify major groups of plants with their scientific name and economic importance, after identifying key characters of the representing group.
