### 4 About The Cochin College:

The Cochin College was founded on July 15, 1967, in response to an increasing demand for higher education in Western Kochi. The college symbolizes the hopes and aspirations of the public of Western Kochi and is a milestone in the crowded history of this commercial town. Slowly and steadily, the institution grew into a post-graduate college in 1995 from its humble beginnings as a junior college in 1967. The college was accredited with a B Grade (2.85) by NAAC, UGC in January 2021.

The college is sponsored by the Cochin Education Society, which was founded as a result of the joint efforts of the Indian Chamber of Commerce and the former Mattancherry Municipal Council. This college is affiliated with Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam, and offers various courses in both Science and Humanities at the degree level, such as Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Botany, Commerce, Economics, English Literature.
