5 Report of INIZIO-2022: Student Induction Programme

The College successfully conducted the INIZIO 2022 - Student Induction Programme from 12th to 16th December 2022, designed to welcome and orient the first-year undergraduate students to the college environment. The program, conducted in both online and offline modes, followed the Deeksharambh guidelines provided by the University Grants Commission (UGC), which aim to ensure a smooth transition of students into higher education.

The induction program featured a variety of sessions and activities to familiarize students with the academic, social, and cultural life at The Cochin College. Notable among these were interactive training sessions conducted by HABIT THEORY, focusing on themes such as:

Boosting Memory and Willpower: Practical techniques for improving focus and resilience. The Academic Orientation was handled by the respective departments, introducing students to their courses, faculty, and career prospects. Sessions on health and well-being, the SWAYAM portal for online learning, and the use of cloud tools for academic purposes were also part of the induction.

These activities provided opportunities for personal development and expression, ensuring students felt involved from the very beginning.

The program saw active participation from approximately 350-400 students, who gained a comprehensive understanding of college life, academic expectations, and personal growth opportunities. 11 Report on Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav Celebrations at The Cochin College

As part of the nationwide Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav initiative, The Cochin College organized a series of events and activities to commemorate 75 years of Indian independence.
